## *The Vintage*

### *The Vineyards*

This Rose' bottling comes from Kraemer Vineyard, near Silverton, Willamette Valley appellation. The fruit was handpicked, and hand sorted.

### *The Cellar*

Harvested on September 15 at 22.4 Brix; this Rosé fruit was destemmed, crushed, and soaked on skins for 36 hours before pressing. The juice was racked to a stainless-steel tank and inoculated with Delta yeast. The wine did not go through Malo-Lactic fermentation and was racked and sterile filtered at bottling.

### *The Wine*

The 2021 Torii Mor Rosé has a beautiful, brilliant light pink color, with a forward-sweet aroma, a mix of flowers, tropical fruit and red berries.

The flavors show a refreshing bright acidity with grapefruit, kiwi, passion fruit, ripe strawberries and watermelon. The mouth-feel is sweet, bright and juicy, with rich texture and a long and bright red-fruited finish.

This Rosé is ready to be enjoyed now.
